The battery energy storage system (BESS), with 200MW capacity, will hold 800 megawatt hours (MWh) of power, enough to back 96,000 households. The development tracks the project's construction permit given in July 2023 ...

French utility company ENGIE has begun the construction of an 800MWh Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) at its Vilvoorde site in Belgium, which they are calling one of the largest battery parks in Europe.

With an installed capacity of 200 MW on a 3.5-hectare site, BESS Vilvoorde will be able to store 800 MWh of energy in 320 battery modules measuring 25 m x 4 m x 3 m, and release it to the grid for four hours. Equivalent to 160,000 5 kWh domestic batteries, it will cover the electricity consumption of 96,000 households.
