What is akaysha doing in Australia?

Akaysha has a programme to build-out more than 1GW of battery storage assets across nine projects in the National Electricity Market in Australia. At full capacity, Akaysha's projects will help accelerate the roll-out of a further 4GW of supply of clean, affordable renewable energy across Australia.

Does akaysha energy have a guaranteed power capacity?

Akaysha Energy is guaranteed to provide a continuous active power capacity of at least 700 MW. The project also includes a guaranteed useable energy storage capacity of at least 1400 MWh.

What is akaysha energy's first battery storage investment in Asia-Pacific?

The deal was executed through the company's Climate Infrastructure business and is its first battery storage investment in the Asia-Pacific (APAC) region. Akaysha Energy's portfolio comprises nine battery storage assets,including Ulinda Park,a 150MW/300MWh battery project located in the west of Brisbane.

Did Blackrock buy akaysha energy?

US-based investment giant BlackRock has acquired Akaysha Energy, an Australian firm that has more than 1GW of energy storage capacity in its portfolio. The financial details of the deal have not been disclosed. BlackRock has committed to investing more than A\$1bn (\$700m) to support the development of battery storage assets in Australia.
