A 44-megawatt solar power plant, among the largest in the region, is to be constructed at the University of Bahrain. Expected to produce around 75 gigawatt-hours of electricity each year, the project will use large portions of the university's parking areas and open spaces for solar panels.

Muharraq, Bahrain (updated: November 15, 2024) A solar power facility is being developed at a university campus in Bahrain to generate approximately 75 GWh of clean energy annually. The initiative aims to support Bahrain's commitment to reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 30% by 2035 and achieving net-zero emissions by 2060.

The Electricity and Water Authority (EWA) of Bahrain has released a tender for a new solar power project.
