Who is eligible for Pradhan Mantri solar Yojana?

As mentioned before, the citizens (with yearly income up to Rs. 1 to 1.5 lakhs) who are under the poverty line (BPL) or belong to the middle-class are eligible for the Pradhan Mantri Solar Yojana.

How does PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijlee Yojana work?

The scheme provides for a subsidy of 60% of the solar unit cost for systems up to 2kW capacity and 40 percent of additional system cost for systems between 2 to 3kW capacity. The subsidy has been capped at 3kW capacity.

What is PM Surya Ghar Yojana?

Through PM Surya Ghar Yojana, the government plans to promote the use of solar energy. Installing the rooftop solar panels on one crore houses will help in reducing the country's dependency on fossil fuel-based electricity. It will also make the maximum use of the sunshine which is available for 6-8 months of the year in most parts of the country.

Originally intended to fully subsidise installation of 1-3 Kilowatt (KW) solar systems in 1 crore households, the scheme now offers up to 60% coverage of costs, with households required to cover the remainder, albeit with accessible loans.

This target was extended to 2026 as it could not be achieved on time. The new scheme, Pradhan Mantri Suryodaya Yojana, is an effort to reach the 40 GW rooftop solar capacity ...
