

What are Bonaire & Sint Eustatius?

These are the islands of Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, and Saba, [10][nb 1] as they are also known in legislation, or the BES islands (an acronym of their names; most people believe, however, it's an acronym for 'Bijzondere Eilandelijke Status' meaning special island status) for short.

Who is the representative of Bonaire Sint Eustatius & Saba?

The Representative for the public bodies of Bonaire, Sint Eustatius and Saba represents the Government of the Netherlands on the islands and also performs tasks similar to a King's Commissioner. [citation needed] The current representative is Gilbert Isabella.

Are Bonaire and Sint-Eustatius honoured?

Late last week, the good news was received that the project proposals of Bonaire, Sint-Eustatius and Saba were honoured. They are the only islands in the Caribbean whose proposals made it through the selection.

Where are Sint Eustatius & Saba?

Sint Eustatius and Saba are in the main Lesser Antilles group, south of Sint Maarten (a constituent country of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, along with Curacao and Aruba.). Saba and Sint Eustatius are also (there is some debate about this) part of the Windward Islands and are volcanic and hilly, with little ground suitable for agriculture.

Where is Bonaire located?

Bonaire is part of the ABC islands within the Leeward Antilles island chain off the Venezuelan coast. The Leeward Antilles have a mixed volcanic and coral origin. Saba and Sint Eustatius are part of the SSS islands within the Leeward Islands. They are located east of Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.

Is Bonaire part of the Netherlands Antilles?

The BES Islands were part of the Netherlands Antilles until the country's dissolution in 2010, when the islands became special municipalities, within the country of the Netherlands. English, Dutch and Spanish are spoken alongside the local tongue, Papiamentu, in Bonaire. The currency in all three islands is the US dollar.
