Are reefer containers a problem in Brazil?

Food producers in Brazil, one of the world's biggest agricultural nations and a major exporter of perishables such as chicken, beef, and bananas, is hit hard by a shortage of reefer containers servicing the southern part of the country.

Is there a shortage of refrigerated containers in Rio Grande do Sul?

Will container demand increase in Santos by 2025?

In the country's main port, container demand already reached its operational limit in 2019. By 2025, there is a possibility that the volume of cargo will exceed total installed capacity, according to the companies' projections. "The average wait for a ship to dock in Santos is enormous, which means an increase in logistics costs.

How many TEUs are not transported in the port of Santos?

The organization calculates that around 500,000 TEUsare not transported in the Port of Santos each year due to these restrictions, considering routes to Asia, Europe, and the Mediterranean. In terms of value, this means an annual loss of \$20.6 billion, between imports and exports, the association estimates.

How many TEUs does Brazil receive?

Today, Brazil receives ships of up to 11,500 TEUs. The next step would be to receive ships of 13,000 TEUs to 16,000 TEUs, which are up to 366-meter long. However, shipping companies complain that even vessels of 11,500 TEUs cannot operate at full capacity in Santos, due to depth restrictions.
