

Building a solar farm Iraq

Will TotalEnergies build a solar farm in Iraq?

The new project is TotalEnergies' second GW-scale project in Iraq. Image: TotalEnergies French energy major TotalEnergies has agreed to build a 1GW solar farm in the Basra region of southern Iraq in a deal that also sees substantial investments in new gas networks and seawater treatment totalling US\$10 billion.

Will a solar power plant be built in Iraq?

Solar power plant. Source: Gamesa Electric French energy major TotalEnergies SE (EPA:TTE) is set to start work on a project for the construction of a 1-GW solar park in southern Iraq after getting the green light from the local government last week.

Where will a 1 GW solar plant be built in Iraq?

The gigawatt-scale solar plant will be built in the Artawi oil field in Basra Governorate. In April, the French power major said it intends to invite Saudi company ACWA Power Co (TADAWUL:2082) to join the development of a 1-GW solar project in Iraq without disclosing more details.

Does Iraq need solar energy?

Iraq has abundant untapped solar resources that could allow it to achieve its target and reduce reliance on imports of electricity. Additionally, the cost of electricity powered by solar energy is lower than that of oil- or gas-fired energy.

How much gas does Iraq produce a day?

Iraq produces around 3 billion cubic feet of natural gas per day, nearly all of which falls under oil production. Because of insufficient infrastructure, almost half of the gas burns into the atmosphere, leading to gas shortages and emitting an estimated 36 million tons of CO₂ annually.

TotalEnergies SE and QatarEnergy have signed an agreement to form a 50-50 joint venture to build a photovoltaic farm with a peak production of 1.25 gigawatts (GW) in Iraq's Basra region.

Iraq is planning to build solar plants and its first green hydrogen project as part of a strategy to tackle power shortages and reduce its carbon footprint. The country's cabinet has approved a proposal to install 12 gigawatts (GW) of solar power by 2030, said a National Investment Commission representative, Rahim Al Jaafari.

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
