

Can the bay window knock down the locker

Do action wall ties repair bay windows?

Kent based Action Wall ties repair bay windows suffering from cracks, movement or dropped lintels and arches. Existing masonry is repaired and reinforced.

What happened to the masonry around the ground floor bay window?

Located in Wandsworth, SW8, this Victorian/Edwardian home had clearly visible dropping and cracking masonry around the ground floor bay window. Shortly after the initial inspection, the masonry failed and the brickwork of the bay window collapsed.

Are bay windows cracking?

Cracking as a result of movement is one of the more worrying defects faced by homeowners and recently we have inspected a number of period properties where cracking has appeared in and around bay windows. In 1894 building regulations were revised so as to allow windows to stand proud from external walls.

How was a bay window reconnected to the main brickwork?

Stainless steel corded joint reinforcements were installed to form a deep masonry beam. This redistributes the upper-storey loads and restrains diagonal cracking and bulging tendencies. The bay window brickwork was reconnected to the main brickwork by the installation of remedial grouted helical bars.

Should a bay window be positioned at the front of a property?

When a bay window is positioned at the front of a property that is exposed to the road, privacy can be compromised, though this can be remedied with the addition of blinds, shutters, curtains or obscured glass. Higher maintenance.

Why did the ground floor bay window masonry and brickwork bulge?

The ground floor bay window masonry and brickwork arches had visible cracking, dropping and significant outward leaning. A large gap had opened up between the brickwork columns and the box sash windows. This serious lack of structural integrity was also causing the 1st floor brickwork to bulge.
