What climate zone is Comoros in?

Does Comoros have a spring season?

Comoros does not experience a typical spring season due to its location near the equator. However, during the months of March to May, which can be analogized to a temperate spring season, the country sees increased rainfall with average temperatures ranging from 25°C (77°F) to 28°C (82.4°F).

How long is the rainy season in Comoros?

The rainy season has experienced increasing irregularity, but overall, it has shortened in duration from 6 months to around 3 months. During 1960-1975, Comoros experienced a decrease in precipitation, followed by a sharp increase in rainfall in 1976, and then followed by increased irregularity between 1977-1989.

When is the best time to visit Comoros?

Precipitation is distributed evenly across all months, with the average monthly rainfall measuring at least 60mm (2.36"). This persistent humidity creates an overall damp environment, with regular morning mists that usually clear up by noon. The ideal time to visit Comoros is during the cooler, drier season, typically from May to November.

What is the wettest season in Comoros?

Winter, from December to February, is the wettest and hottest season in Comoros. Average temperatures hover between 26°C (78.8°F) to 30°C (86°F), and heavy rainfall becomes a common occurrence, reaching monthly totals of over 200mm (7.87").
