What type of plug sockets are in Ivory Coast?

In Ivory Coast the power plug sockets are of type C and E. The standard voltage is 230 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. Which power plug sockets in Ivory Coast? Since type F plugs are identical to type E plugs, they can also be used with type E sockets. Côte d'Ivoire has standardized on the same plugs and receptacles as France, just like almost all other former French colonies. What is the mains voltage in Côte d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast)?

In Ivory Coast, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type C and type E are used. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz.
