

Will Morocco build a 400 MW solar photovoltaic park?

The Moroccan Agency for Sustainable Energy (MASEN) has published the results of the pre-qualifications for the construction of the 400 MW Noor Midelt III solar photovoltaic park. At least three Moroccan companies are in the running, alongside multinationals specialising in renewable energy.

Will Morocco build a third solar farm in the Noor Midelt programme?

The Moroccan Agency for Sustainable Energy (MASEN) has published the results of a call for tenders for the construction of the third solar farm in the Noor Midelt programme. Among the fifteen independent power producers (IPPs) are three Moroccan companies. Green Of Africa is in the running with its Spanish partner Acciona Generacion Renovable.

Will China build a battery cell factory in Morocco?

The Chinese battery cell manufacturer and Volkswagen partner Gotion High-Tech has signed an investment agreement with the Moroccan government for a battery cell factory in the country. The initial production capacity will be 20 GWh, but this figure could increase significantly at a later date.

Will Morocco build a battery factory?

Gotion High-Tech and the Moroccan government had already signed a letter of intent for the battery factory a year ago. Even then, there was talk of up to 100 GWh, but the information available was still thin on the ground. For example, no dates were given for the factory construction schedule.

Who is the bidder for Noor Midelt III solar power plant?

Spain's Iberdrola Renovables Internacional is the sole bidder for the Noor Midelt III solar power plant concession. The plant, which will have a capacity of 400 MWp, will be equipped with a battery-based electricity storage system with a capacity of around 400 MWh.

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The Moroccan Agency for Sustainable Energy (Masen) has published a list of the pre-qualified bidders for the tender for the Noor Midelt III a 400 MW solar plant that will be connected to 400 MWh of battery storage project planned for the Dr#226;a-Tafilalet region in northeastern Morocco.

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4 ???#0183; Battery industry giants, including South Korea's LG and China's Gotion, have announced three major electric vehicle battery plants in Morocco in recent months. But the sourcing of their critical metals remains a major unknown factor.

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The competitive process will seek to select a private partner to finance, build and operate the photovoltaic (PV) park near the town of Midelt in the Atlas mountains, along with a 400-MWh battery energy storage system (BESS). Interested parties will be able to submit their proposals by October 20.

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The project will combine a solar PV array with a battery energy storage system. The document said its expected net capacity during off-peak hours will be 200MWac and is not to exceed 230MW, measured at the delivery point. During peak hours, the project is expected to provide around 400MWh of energy from the BESS.

This envisages 1GW of new onshore solar and wind capacity near Morocco's Atlantic coast in the
