Guatemala set an ambitious target for 80% of its electricity to be generated from renewable sources by 2027. However, renewables only made 36% of the energy mix in 2021, with hydroelectricity taking a significant share.

Renewable Energy in Guatemala. Guatemala plans to fuel 80% of its electricity matrix with renewable energy by 2030. Guatemala's policy for rural electrification focuses on renewable energy sources such as solar PV, wind, small hydroelectric plants, and hybrid power plants.

Enerland Group, a Spanish firm, has announced its expansion into Guatemala's renewable energy market with the inauguration of its headquarters in the country and the commencement of construction on its inaugural photovoltaic park, Magdalena Solar, boasting a capacity of 66 MWp.

Low-carbon energy infrastructure developer MPC Energy Solutions (MPCES) announced today the start of construction works on a 65-MWp solar project in Guatemala, the largest project in its portfolio so far.

The National Energy Plan of Guatemala defines the promotion of renewables as a priority. The plan aims to promote the use of clean and environmentally friendly energy for domestic consumption without losing sight of energy security and the need for supply
