Through different research studies conducted by Rwanda Energy Group-Energy Development Corporation limited (REG-EDCL) Rwanda has identified four geothermal potential prospects, Karisimbi, Rubavu, Bugarama and Kinigi. So far, only two exploration wells have been drilled in Karisimbi to 3,015 and 1,367 m depth, respectively.

Rwanda Energy Group provides energy in the whole country through four different main areas: Generation; Transmission, Distribution and Access to electricity. **ELECTRICITY ACCESS PROJECTS**. Electricity access is still low in the country, around 67.1% of the population have access to electricity (48.6% on-grid and 18.5% off-grid).
