How much do solar panels cost in Georgia?

As of October 2024, the average solar panel system costs \$2.63/W including installation in Georgia. For a 5 kW installation, this comes out to about \$13,173 before incentives, though prices range from \$11,197 to \$15,149. After the federal tax credit, the average price drops by 30%. You'll probably pay even less than what we show here.

How much does a 6 kW solar system cost in Georgia?

The federal solar investment tax credit (ITC) is the biggest factor reducing the cost of going solar in Georgia. If you install a residential solar panel system by the end of 2032, you receive a federal income tax credit equal to 30% of the system's total cost. That includes equipment, labor and permits.

Do solar panels increase home value in Georgia?

Yes, solar panels increase home value in Georgia. Typically, you can expect to boost your home's value by around 4.1%. Based on the average Georgia house price, that's an increase of \$12,204, a significant increase.
