

What size solar panel do I Need?

How many solar panels do I Need?

The number and size of your solar panels depend on the size of your property and energy demands. A 4kW solar system is one of the most popular sizes for domestic solar systems, as it is typically appropriate for homes with 3 to 4 people. So in this case, you'd need something like 10 solar panels installed on your roof, each at a power of 400 kW.

Installing a 5kW solar panel system costs £7,500 - £8,500 and can lead to annual savings of up to £600 on your energy bills.; You can expect to break even on your investment in a 5kW solar ...

A typical 4kW solar panel system for 2-3 bedroom houses costs £5,000 - £6,000 with installation.Added together, the total cost of solar panels and a battery in the UK is £13,000 -



£15,500.

Smaller system sizes drop off in ROI as the price per kW installed is more expensive. Unless there is limited roof space, it is rare to see systems installed that are smaller than 6kW. You can input your own electricity ...
