

How much does a solar panel cost in the UK?

The average cost of a solar panel in the UK based on a 350-watt panel is currently between £500 and £800. However, please bear in mind that this is the price for a single solar panel and does not include the professional installation or any other extras e.g. pigeon proofing. With that said, let's explore some common solar installation scenarios...

### How much does a solar panel cost per kilowatt?

Exactly how much a solar panel costs per kilowatt depends on the type of solar panel you're talking about. Monocrystalline solar panels are the most expensive, and their cost per kW is somewhere around £1,000 - £1,500whereas polycrystalline solar panels cost about £900 per kW.

#### How much does a 3.5 kWp solar panel system cost?

A 3.5 kWp solar panel system would typically require around 10 solar panels (at 350 W each) and cost between £5,000 and £10,000. \*kWp stands for 'kilowatt peak'. This is the amount of power that a solar panel or array will produce per hour in prime conditions.

#### What is included in a complete solar panel installation?

Please bear in mind that a complete solar panel installation does not simply include the costs of the solar panels themselves, but also includes the following: Solar panel brackets. Solar panel inverter. Solar panel brackets. Installation i.e. labour costs of the installer. Cost of the solar battery storage system (although this is optional).

#### How much does a solar panel installation cost?

Generally, two installers will work together to install your solar panel system, and depending on its complexity, they can take up to 3 days to complete the installation. This means that you can expect to spend anywhere between £600 and £3,000 on labour costs alone.

#### How much do monocrystalline solar panels cost?

The exact cost of monocrystalline solar panels will vary depending on the manufacturer and the size of the solar panels. As a rule of thumb,monocrystalline solar panels have their highest price point at about £1 - £1.50 per Watt. Polycrystalline solar panels,on the other hand,have a lower efficiency rating than monocrystalline panels.
