How do I get a solar PV grant in Ireland?

The grant is administered by the Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland (SEAI). You must apply for the grant and get a grant offer from the SEAI before you get your solar panels and start any work. You can also get SEAI grants for solar PV for your business or a non-domestic building.

How much solar power does ESB have in Ireland?

Back to Press Releases 26 February 2024 ESB Networks can confirm that it has 1,000 MW (one Giga Watt) of solar PV generation connected to Ireland's electricity network. This figure includes 500 MW of utility-scale solar connections, 369 MW of which is from larger projects connected to the transmission system, managed by EirGrid.
