

# Is it okay to lay photovoltaic panels on top of sandwich panels

Can you put a solar panel on a thatched roof?

Thatched roofs are not suitable for solar panels. There's no mounting system designed for thatch, which wouldn't be ventilated well enough underneath the panels and so would rot. And given that thatched roofs already present a fire risk, putting an electrical system on top wouldn't be sensible!

Can a flat roof hold solar panels?

This is because a solar panel system usually weighs about 20kg per square metre, which the great majority of roofs can hold. However, flat roofs may not always be strong enough for solar panels. Drilling into a flat roof can cause leaks, so an installer will usually ballast the panels instead - but these will add around 80kg per panel.

Where should a photovoltaic system be installed?

The ideal place to put a photovoltaic system is on the rooftop, as it's generally the spot most exposed to the sun and would otherwise be unused space. But which types of roof are suitable for solar panels? The first step is to make sure you own your roof.

Should I replace my flat roof before installing solar panels?

The majority of flat roofs are made of traditional felt, which has a lifespan of approximately 15 years. So if your flat roof is over 10 years old, it would definitely be worth replacing it before installing solar panels. The same applies if you are planning to build an extension on your home and place solar panels on the flat roof.

Do you need an electrician to install solar panels on a roof?

Proper electrical connections are vital for efficient solar panel operation on a roof system. How do flat roof solar panels work?

Once the flat roof solar panels have been installed, they will absorb energy from the sun and convert it into electricity. The one drawback with stationary flat roof solar panels is that they can't turn to face the sun's direction. This is where an automatic solar tracker system comes into play.

If the sun sets in front of you, it's west-facing; if it sets to the left, it's north-facing; and if it sets on the opposite side of the property, it's east-facing. Here's how an installer will decide if your roof is suitable for solar panels, ...
