The Central African Republic is predicted to have a population of 5 017 604 people in 2022 with an urbanisation rate of 1.85%.

Demographic profile. The Central African Republic's (CAR) humanitarian crisis has worsened since the coup of March 2013. CAR's high mortality rate and low life expectancy are attributed to elevated rates of preventable and treatable diseases (including malaria and malnutrition), an inadequate health care system, precarious food security, and armed conflict.

Landlocked in the heart of Africa; Central African Republic (CAR); has very low urbanization level (40%), and one of the poorest and most fragile countries which scored 188th out of 189 countries by the 2020 UNH Development Index with a low national installed capacity of 41.20 MW and only 32.40% access rate mainly in the capital.

2.8 million people - 46% of the Central African population - will be extremely vulnerable, to the extent that humanitarian aid alone will not be enough for their well-being. In 2023, approximately seven out of 10 Central Africans live below the poverty line, with less than USD 2.15 a day, making CAR one of the 10 poorest countries in the world.
