

Is Kuwait ready for a zero-carbon future?

Director General of (KISR) Dr. Mashan Al-Otaibi ABU DHABI, April 17 (KUNA) -- Kuwait on Wednesday declared updating its renewable energy goals and enhancing strategies of energy efficiency, affirming its outstanding role for a zero-carbon future in line with continued commitments to sustainability and renewable energy.

Does Kuwait have a renewables market?

Electricity is also heavily subsidised, which has limited the development of Kuwait's renewables market. Kuwait holds about 7 percent of global oil reserves and has one of the lowest crude oil production costs of around \$10 per barrel.

How much energy does Kuwait use?

Kuwaiti citizens account for 30% of the total population, but they use about two-thirds of the total amount of energy consumed in the country. Average temperatures hover in the upper 40s Celsius during summer months. Over the past few years, these "summer" months have extended from April to October.

Does Kuwait need a new energy strategy?

To ensure economic development and social prosperity in the years to come, Kuwait will require a new energy strategy, combined with a plan to foster economic diversification and reduce fossil fuel dependency.

What is the future of Kuwait's Electricity sector?

The Ministry of Electricity and Water estimates that reserve margins could drop to 8% by 2020. Kuwait plans to increase base-load electricity generating capacity to 32 GW by 2035 (see Chapter 2). Until very recently, the Ministry of Electricity and Water was solely responsible for the development of the electricity sector.

Kuwait has had long-term plans to raise its oil production capacity to 4 million barrels per day, now targeted for 2035, with 3.65 mb/d coming from its main upstream entity Kuwait Oil Company and the remaining 350,000 b/d from Kuwait's half of the Partitioned Neutral Zone it shares with Saudi Arabia.

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Kuwait still has a way to go on its energy transition, industry experts say, despite the announcement of a 20-year renewables strategy. Salem Al-Hajraf, minister of electricity, water and renewable energy, said on March 7 that the country is targeting carbon neutrality by 2050.
