Lamsan Power Corporation is a Department of Energy and ARMM-Regional Board of Investments registered corporation. Its on-going projects include a 1x15mW biomass-fired power plant and a 1x5.5mW/57tph steam cogeneration plant. The 15mW power plant is already a DOE and RBOI registered project.

Who is lamsan Holdings Corporation?

Lamsan Holdings Corporation is the parent company of the Lamsan Group of Companies. The primary area of operations of its business units lie within Maguindanao, which is at the heart of the Bangsamoro Region.

Who is the lamsan group?

It traces its roots from Lamsan Trading Inc., a corn and rice trading firm, established in 1965. For the past half century, the Lamsan Group is driven by its continuing commitment and belief in the potential of the Bangsamoro Region and its people.

Why did lamsan start a biomass cogeneration system?

The staple item of the Santomean diet and standard restaurant fare is fish - grelhado - grilled, baked (asado) or to a lesser degree cooked/boiled (cozido).The most popular are flying fish (peixe voador), and you will see these cut open and laid out to dry on the beach or in drying sheds in large quantities.
