

#### What is the power sector in Malawi?

Revised in July 2023, this map provides a detailed view of the power sector in Malawi. The locations of power generation facilities that are operating, under construction or planned are shown by type - including liquid fuels, coal, geothermal, hybrid, hydroelectricity, solar PV, wind and biomass/biogas.

#### How will the Malawi electricity access project contribute to ref development?

### Why should Malawi develop a long-term power generation plan?

Considering the challenges and future energy demand projections, the Government of Malawi (GoM) needs to develop a long-term power generation plan with emphasis on future energy mix. In addition, the development of a reliable transmission and distribution system is a must. This will help in reducing transmission and distribution losses. 2.

#### How will the Malawi electrification program work?

The success of the Malawi electrification program will depend in part on the technical proficiency that is developed by ESCOM, MAREP and the future REA to plan, design and oversee construction activities for grid densification, grid expansion and off-grid energy systems. Training will be required to build capacity.

### How did JICA support the government of Malawi?

JICA supported the Government of Malawi in constructing a 19.1 MW Tedzani IV Hydropower Stationwhich was handed over to the Government of Malawi in June 2021. This was an important contribution to the GoM's vision of attaining 1,000 MW energy by the year 2025. The estimated cost of the project was MK 38.33 billion (approximately US\$46.9 million).

### Should Malawi scale-up off-grid electrification access?

Given the power supply deficits that will continue through at least 2022 and the very low rate of electrification access today in rural Malawi, there is an immediate need to scale-up off-grid electrification access to include mini-grids and stand-alone solar solutions.
