What is the political system in the Maldives?

The politics of the Maldives take place in the framework of a presidential representative democratic republic, whereby the President is the Head of Government. Executive power is exercised by the government.

Could India and China be putting the Maldives at risk?

Who is the current president of Maldives?

The current president is Mohamed Muizzu, who was elected in 2023 with a majority of 54.05%, defeating then-president Ibrahim Mohamed Solih. The constitution sets out the rights and duties of the citizens of Maldives and defines the structure of the government of the Maldives.

Are Indian troops in Maldives exaggerated?

Speaking to the BBC before the presidential poll, the outgoing president Mr Solih said fears about the presence of Indian troops were exaggerated. " There are no militarily active overseas personnel stationed in the Maldives.

How is Maldives elected?

On a national level, Maldives elects a head of state - the president - and a legislature. The president is elected for a five-year term by the peoplesince 2008. Until 2005 (after the election), no legal parties existed. The results of the most recent legislative elections held in 2024 are:
