#### **Myanmar Solar Generator Scam**

How many people have been forced to work in scam centres in Myanmar?

It was then that I doubted they would let me live," Ravi said. In August 2023,the UN estimated that more than 120,000 people,most of them men from Asia,had been forced to work in scam centres in Myanmar like the one Ravi found himself in. The centres are fed by a steady stream of aspiring migrant workers from all over the world.

Are romance scams happening in Myanmar?

While scam centres have popped up across South East Asia, they have been particularly prevalent in Myanmar, where they have generated billions of dollars for both Chinese underworld crime syndicates, and the various armed groups operating in border towns. In this particular scam centre, the focus was so-called romance scams.

What is the scam industry in Southeast Asia?

The scam industry has boomed across Southeast Asia since the COVID-19 pandemic; by the end of 2023, syndicates in the region were using online fraud schemes to rob people around the world of some \$64bn annually, according to a report published in May by the United States Institute of Peace.

How does Mr Yan scam work?
