How much solar power does Poland have?

Poland's cumulative installed PV capacity hit 17.05 GW at the end of 2023, according to a new report from Instytut Energetyki Odnawialnej (IEO). At the end of 2022, the country's installed solar capacity had reached 12.4 GW, which means new PV additions hit 4.6 GW last year.

Recently, a rapid development of solar energy has been observed in Poland and is estimated that the country now has about 700,000 photovoltaic prosumers. Prosumers in Poland have still the highest share in the photovoltaic market, and in 2022 they represented 68% of the annual growth of power installed in photovoltaics. The net-billing system results in a higher self-consumption index, since PV installations are more optimally sized due to the settlement method of surplus electrical power produced.
