Will a solar power plant save money in Chad?

In Chad, Power Africa transaction advisory and technical assistance helped secure a \$20.6 million (EUR18 million) loan to bring the 42 MW Djermaya Solar project to financial close.

InnoVent has therefore decided to develop the country's first solar power plant, by implanting it in Abéché, the second largest city in Chad with 80,000 inhabitants, but which is not connected to the national electricity grid.

Currently, ZIZ Energie owns and operates five diesel powered minigrids in Chad, which it plans to convert to solar-plus-storage hybrid systems starting in the city of Mongo, the 70,000-inhabitant capital region of Gu&#233;ra province. ZIZ Energie is installing a 2.5 MWp solar PV power plant in Mongo with an energy storage system and back-up generators.

Chad is endowed with the tenth-largest oil reserves in Africa, as well as solar and wind resource potential. The majority of its existing capacity comes from diesel, natural gas and heavy fuel oil generation. Chad is living an energy crisis that undermines its development possibilities with extremely limited electricity access (8%).
