What is WeChat Pay?

WeChat Pay is a payment feature integrated into the WeChat app, users can complete payment quickly with smartphones. WeChat has Quick Pay, QR Code Payments, In-App Web-Based Payments, and Native In-App Payments, all to fulfill the full range of scenarios your customers expect to fulfill different payment situations.

What is WeChat Pay (Weixin pay)?

WeChat Pay, officially referred to as Weixin Pay (Chinese: 微信支付; pinyin: Wēixīn Zhīfù) in China, is a mobile payment and digital wallet service by WeChat based in China that allows users to make mobile payments and online transactions. As of March 2016, WeChat Pay had over 300 million users.

How does WeChat work?

Merchants scan the code to take the payment. Users open WeChat to scan the code, confirm the amount, and make the payment after passing the security checks. Users pay for goods or services in Mini Programs created inside WeChat. Users can pay for goods and services inside the merchant's Official Account.

Is WeChat Pay better than other mobile payment systems?

WeChat has nearly 1.3 billion monthly active users, making it the second largest mobile payment giant after Alipay, and WeChat Pay accounts for 39.53% of China's mobile payment market share. 4. Native Pay (PC websites, physical stores, media advertising) Native payment refers to the mode in which the merchant system generates a payment QR code according to the WeChat payment agreement, and the user then uses WeChat to "scan" to complete the payment.

Where can I use WeChat Pay HK?

In the same year, Tencent introduced "WeChat Pay HK", a payment service for users in Hong Kong. Transactions are carried out with the Hong Kong dollar. In 2019 it was reported that Chinese users can use WeChat Pay in 25 countries outside of China, including Italy, South Africa and the UK.
