Wallis and Futuna is made up of three main volcanic tropical islands along with a number of tiny islets, and is split into two island groups that lie about 160 miles apart, namely the Wallis Islands in the northeast, and the Hoorn Islands, also known as the Futuna Islands, in the southwest, including Futuna Island proper and the mostly uninhabited Alofi Island.

Wallis and Futuna Islands has a population of 11,278 people, as of July 1, 2024. Wallis and Futuna Islands's population is equivalent to 0.00% of the total world population. In 2024, Wallis and Futuna Islands's population will decrease with -85 people.

TO outsiders it may look like an island paradise but a right royal dispute has disrupted the peacefulness of the French Pacific territory of Wallis and Futuna. Disenchantment with the choice of a new king has caused tensions to boil over and dozens of protesters have stormed the palace on Wallis to prevent his enthronement tomorrow.

In 1991, BNP Nouvelle-Calédonie, a subsidiary of BNP Paribas, established a subsidiary, Banque de Wallis-et-Futuna, in the territory. Two years earlier Banque Indosuez had closed its branch at Mata-Utu, leaving the territory without any bank. Following this, the Bank of Wallis-and-Futuna (BWF) with its head office in Wallis was created in 1991.
