

Mobile communications services are currently provided by two service providers, MTN Eswatini and Eswatini Mobile, that use 2G, 3G and 4G (LTE) technologies. They have a combined network coverage of over 99% population coverage for 2G, 90% for 3G and almost 60% coverage for 4G/LTE.

MTN Eswatini consolidates dominance in the mobile market, expands LTE service reach, reduces the cost of monthly data bundles; Government develops National Cybersecurity Strategy running to 2025; Regulator imposes sliding scale reduction in call termination rates through to 2023, introduces the Fixed Services Band Plan;

The Eswatini Communications Commission (ESCCOM) is the regulatory body responsible for regulating the communications sector in Eswatini, constituting of telecommunication services and networks, broadcasting services, postal services and the use and allocation of radio spectrum.

By drawing from global telecom experiences, EPTC has developed a unique hybrid connectivity model that aligns with Eswatini's diverse urban and rural needs. As a landlocked country, Eswatini relies on neighboring nations for international bandwidth, resulting in relatively high access costs and lower market penetration.

Broadband is defined as a high-speed internet access service providing down-load speeds of at least 256 kbit/s (ITU definition).
