



# Solar energy for electricity Tonga

Producing energy since August this year, and providing power for up to 10,336 households, the Solar Farm is helping The Government of Tonga pursue its National Energy Roadmap plans to see up to 70% of Tongatapu's electricity generation sourced from renewables by the end of 2025.

Tonga is heavily dependent on expensive, imported diesel fuels for power generation but has committed to a goal of generating 70 per cent of its electricity from renewable sources by 2025.

In 2022, Tonga's electricity consumption was heavily reliant on fossil fuels, with more than 85% of its electricity derived from such sources. Low-carbon, or clean energy, made up the remaining 12.5%, entirely from solar power. This means that solar energy is the only source of low-carbon electricity in Tonga, which indicates a significant opportunity for expansion in this area.
