How many solar panels are there in Guernsey?

A solar panel project at a Guernsey charity is now complete and will power about 40 homes, Guernsey Electricity said. There are 310 photovoltaic panels on the roof of the newly reopened Guernsey Rural Occupational Workshop (Grow) site. The charity worked with Guernsey Electricity and The Little Green Energy Company on the scheme.

What are Guernsey's on-Island initiatives?

Alan Bates, CEO at Guernsey Electricity, said: "These on-island initiatives are designed to increase the amount of electricity generated from local renewable sources. "The electricity feeds directly into the island's network so that all our customers can benefit from locally generated, clean solar energy."

Will solar panels replace greenhouses?

The greenhouses, which cover 80% of the site, will be replaced by solar panels, which are expected to generate 2.95MW of renewable energy, which is more than half of the island's 2025 target. The States' new Electricity Strategy has targets of achieving 5MW of renewable energy by 2025 and 10MW by 2028.

Guernsey Housing Association has specified Grant Solar Thermal Systems on a development of 58 high spec eco-properties in St Sampson. The houses on the Sir John Leale Avenue development, Victoria Avenue, have been designed with many energy saving features, to ensure highly efficient home heating and lower fuel bills for residents.

A typical Guernsey home has at least one roof that faces east, south or west, or a flat roof that may be open to all the sun's orientations. From a few panels to four panels or more and typically 6 to 10 panels, you can

maximise your generation by maximising your roof spaces.
