How do I apply for solar panels?

Fill Out the Application Form: Your name, CNIC number, contact information, full address of the property where the solar panels will be put, and the amount of electricity you now use will all be requested on the web form.

Why does the government cover 90% of the cost of solar panels?

By covering 90% of the cost of solar panels, the government ensures that even the poorest households can benefit from renewable energy. This initiative not only helps in reducing electricity costs but also contributes to a greener and more sustainable future.

Who will be considered for solarization?

Owns an electric tubewell with power requirement upto 15 KW will be considered for solarization. (last paid bill of electric tubewell connection will be submitted as a proof of tubewell ownership, nonpayers/defaulters will not be considered). The Tubewell Electricity connection should have been installed on or before 31st March, 2024.

How many families will receive solar panels?

Phase I: At least 450,000 families will receive solar panels. Notification: Selected families will be informed about their status. Payment: The remaining 10% cost will be paid over five years via the electricity bill. Installation Period: September and October.

What are the requirements for solarization of tubewells?

Tubewell with a watertable depth upto 60 feet is eligible. Should have 3-phase electrical connection. A massive awareness campaign will be launched for solarization of tubewells. An advertisement will be published in print media for submission of application by the farmers.

Can you put solar panels on a low-income home?

The property where you intend to place the solar panels must be yours, or you must get the owner's signed consent. Furthermore, as low-income homes are given priority under this system, your monthly power consumption should preferably be less than 100 units.
