

Is Macau a good place to invest in solar energy?

Song and colleagues have no doubts: "Macao has some of the richest solar resources in the world" (with average annual sunlight time exceeding 1000 h, providing about 5000 MJ/m²). "Clearly, Macao has a tremendous potential for developing solar energy, especially a grid-connected photovoltaic system."

What is the new energy ecosystem in Macau?

CEM believes that adequate stability, affordability, and clean efficiency are the three core elements of the new energy ecosystem. Given Macau's high cost of land and mature economy, the SAR Government formulated an energy supply strategy with CSG as the main supplier, supplemented by local power generation.

What is Cem doing in Macau?

In Macau's Dawan District, CEM is currently involved in constructing renewable energy sources such as offshore wind power and solar photovoltaic power generation. It's also involved in building hydropower renewable energy, such as pumped storage and natural gas combined-cycle power generation projects.

Will Cem replace CSG power capacity in Macau by 2030?

CEM's goal is to replace the power capacity Macau imports from CSG with CEM's installed capacity from clean energy in Dawan District by 2030. To this end, Liu says, "Huawei and CEM are cooperating in a power data transmission network, OT system infrastructure construction, and a medium-voltage communication network."

Does offshore wind energy make sense in Macau?

"In our view, as external observers, offshore wind energy in Macau's territorial waters makes sense, as does the development of distributed generation of photovoltaic energy. Macau has a lot of sun and many roofs. There is a potential to develop this vector in the medium-to-long term."

Is natural gas a problem in Macao?

As a member of the Smart Energy Group of UM's State Key Laboratory, which focuses on optimising clean energy use and production, Zhang believes expanding the use of natural gas poses major problems, especially in the city's older districts. "Many buildings and [much of the] infrastructure in Macao are outdated."

The new policy put forward a wide range of energy prices where using electricity during peak hours (the morning and afternoon) costs up to four times more than off-peak. Since peak hours tend to coincide with the sunniest time of day, the policy might encourage greater use of rooftop solar power systems.
