What is the largest solar power station in Israel?

Are photovoltaic solar panels available in Israel?

There are various size fields with photovoltaic solar panels in Israel. These solar energy producers have an agreement with the Israeli government, ensuring the electric company will purchase the energy at a price that fluctuates according to the market's cost production. Where is the Ashalim power station located?

The Ashalim power station is a concentrated solar power station in the Negev desert near the kibbutz of Ashalim, south of the district city of Be'er Sheva in Israel. It consists of three plots with three different technologies through which the station combines 3 kinds of energy: solar thermal energy, photovoltaic energy, and natural gas.

When will Israel's largest solar power plant be built?

In December 2021, it was announced that Shikun & Binui won a contract to build a 330 MW solar power plant near Dimona, which is expected to become Israel's largest upon its completion in 2023. The solar park will also house a 210 MW energy storage facility.
