This is now the fifth solar donation that SolarWorld has made to a hospital in Haiti, with the aim of reducing the hospitals energy reliance on expensive and unreliable diesel generators.

The Solar Electric Light Fund (SELF) today announced that SolarWorld has awarded SELF an in-kind grant of solar panels totaling 100 kilowatts to support the solar electrification of five health clinics for Partners In Health (PIH) in Haiti.

Electricity in Haiti is sporadic and expensive - two factors that could compromise patient care at healthcare facilities such as H&#244;pital Universitaire de Mirebalais. To overcome this challenge, ...
