Under the terms of the agreement, Alight and Svea Solar will develop, build and co-own solar parks on Sveaskog's land. Sveaskog, which is a state-owned company, will lease the land, co-invest between 30% and 49% in the solar parks and own the facilities together with each partner company. Development of the first two projects has already begun.
