

The Ministry of Energy and Mines in Eritrea has initiated a bidding process for the establishment of a 30 MW solar facility in the central region of Dekemhare within the African nation.

Solarcentury, an integrated solar power company with operations across Europe, Latin America, and Africa, has commissioned two solar-hybrid mini-grids, bringing power to the rural communities of Areza and Maidma in Eritrea in East Africa.

Dekemhare Solar PV Park is a 30MW solar PV power project. It is planned in Debub, Eritrea. According to GlobalData, who tracks and profiles over 170,000 power plants worldwide, the project is currently at the permitting stage.

This project is a state-of-the-art hybrid power system, combining solar photovoltaics with lithium batteries and backup diesel generators in a location remote from the country's power grid. The system integrates world-class technologies, including Tesla batteries and Caterpillar generators.

The AfDB has awarded a contract to China Energy Engineering Group for the construction of a 30 MW solar PV plant near Dekemhare, Eritrea. The project includes solar power generation, battery storage, and new transmission infrastructure.



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
